Sermon Discussion Guide

October 16, 2022

READ

Read 1 Samuel 28 and 31 aloud and consider making some observations about the passage.

Sermon Recap: Review the sermon with your group, highlighting the following:

- There is a difference between using God and serving God, and a difference between religion and repentance. (This is a great place to use the *Reflect Question* below.)
- God never tells me that I won't fail at anything; what he tells me is that in all things, success or failure, he will sustain me.
- Unrepentant sinners die a terrible death. Saul gives us a picture of someone dying without God—religious, but utterly destroyed.

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. List out some differences between using God and serving God.
- 2. Read 2 Corinthians 7:8–15. What is the difference between worldly sorrow and godly sorrow? How can we avoid the one and cultivate the other?
- 3. Does genuine repentance equal sinless perfection? What's the difference?
- 4. Step back and consider the rise and fall of Saul in the book of 1 Samuel. What is the narrator trying to teach us about God? What is he teaching us about us? (See *Reflect Question* below).

Weekly Response Questions	Prayer
☐ Reflect: What does God's work in Saul's life teach us about him?	 Ask God to deliver us from becoming a church that uses him and grow us into a church that worships him. Ask God to grant us wisdom to know what genuine repentance is and to practice it. Ask God to help us become a group that cares about each other's long-term maturity in Christ.
