## **Sermon Discussion Guide**

May 15, 2022

## READ

Read Psalm 23 and Genesis 39:2–3, 21–23 aloud and consider making some observations about the passage.

Sermon Recap: Review the sermon with your group, highlighting the following:

- "The presence of the Shepherd is our life, our joy, our safety, and our fulfillment."
- "God is always good, but the arc of God's goodness is longer than we typically think."
- Psalm 23 and the story of Joseph teach us to wait patiently, confidently, authentically, intimately, and expectantly.

## **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. As you consider the story of Joseph in Genesis, what sticks out to you the most?
- 2. The narrator repeatedly emphasizes that God was with Joseph (39:2, 3, 21, 23). What is the effect of God's presence in Joseph's life? What is the writer trying to teach us?
- 3. Name three things in your life that would change if you truly believed in all things that God was with you.
- 4. What does it look like to wait on God? How can we encourage one another in our times of waiting?
